





- •Mark out the **traces and** the **imprint** of the ancient temple

2 LAKE AND DEM












- •Guarantee an enjoyable welcome to visitors at the beginning of their visit


Provide **small facilities** at the foot of any footpath or way to the temples (information, places to rest, food and drink, local guides, specific documentation)


•Let tourists have a rest and introduce them to the site





- •Enforce the nice **footpath** to the temple







- •Enforce the role of the area as **main reference point** for tourists enforce its **centrality** within the whole site providing a **place for big festivals**

6 GREAT TEMPLE












- •Stress the presence of the temple with **two pavilion gates** placed one at the beginning and one at the end of the temple to introduce the site
- •Widen the footpath in front of the temple with a **great panoramic terrace embossed** from the rock cliff



RED CLIFF TEMPLE

















- •Provide an **attractive element** to prompt tourists to extend their visit till the most distant temple within the site

HUMID AREA PLATFORM LABYRINTH














Preserve the **humid area** surrounding the water stream

ACCOMMODATIONS – TEMPORARY MEETINGS














Develop the left branch of the lake to accommodate medium and long tourism


- •Provide visitors with places for **temporary use** for examples during festivals

ACCOMMODATIONS – FLOATING HOTEL












Develop the left branch of the lake to accommodate medium and long tourism

ACCOMMODATIONS – VILLAGE INTO THE WOOD














- •Provide visitors with a **village** realised for **long period stays**

- •Use bungalows and camping pitches






ACCOMODATIONS – MONK-STYLE HOTEL












Provide visitors with a monk-style hotel

MONK TRACK




- •Create a new healthy offer tracing a new itinerary at altitude: a so called "Monk Track" to connect the temples



1 LOWER LAKE












Create a **footpath around the lake** with an **in-out waterfront** shape on the east bank **and at altitude** on the west bank

GARDEN OF THE ERBS













- •Create a footpath to connect the upper with the lower lake

3 UPPER LAKE












•Realise a **non-straight floating** deck as part of the footpath connecting the upper with the lower lake

PANORAMIC AREA












- •Enhance the beauty of the temple by developing a **panoramic area** to appreciate the landscape













NARROW GORGE PARK
